



Disciplinary Measures and Sanctions

Depending on the severity of the breach of conduct, and on whether it is a repeat occurrence, one or more of the sanctions below may be applied.

Athletes

Should an athlete fail to comply with the club's Code of Conduct, the athlete may:

- Be required to apologise to their team-mates, the other team, match referee or team manager.
- Receive a verbal warning from the coach.
- Be dropped from the team.
- Be suspended from training for a specified period.
- Receive a written warning from the club committee.
- Be required to leave the club.

Parents/Carers

Should a parent/carer fail to comply with the club's Code of Conduct, they may:

- Be asked by club committee to make an apology.
- Be given a verbal warning by a club committee member.
- Be asked to meet with the club committee.
- Asked by the club committee not to attend future events / training.
- Be required to accept the exclusion of their dependent from the club.

Coaches, Team Managers and Technical Officers

Should a coach, team manager or technical official fail to comply with the club's Code of Conduct, they may:

- Be asked by club committee to make an apology.
- Be required to meet with the club's Welfare Officer
- Be required to meet with the club committee.
- Be suspended by the club.
- Be required to leave the club.
